Datuk Ali Abdul Kadir's career has included roles as the Executive Chairman and Partner of Ernst & Young and its related firms in Malaysia. He was also the former President of MICPA, chairing both its Executive Committee and Insolvency Practices Committee and co-chairing the Company Law Forum. He was Chairman of Dubai Investment Group (Asia) from 2006 until his retirement in 2008. He was appointed an Adjunct Professor in the Accounting and Business Faculty, University of Malaya (2008-2011) and was then appointed to the Advisory Board of the same Faculty. He was also previously chairman of Milux Corporation Berhad,

Microlink Solutions Berhad and Privasia Technology Berhad.

From 1 March 1999 till 29 February 2004, Datuk Ali Kadir was Chairman of the Securities Commission of Malaysia. He also sat on a number of national committees including the Foreign Investment Committee, the Oversight Committee of National Asset Management Company (Danaharta). On the international front, he was a member of the Exco Board of International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO), chairman of their Asia-Pacific Region Committee and the Islamic Capital Market Working Group. He was trustee of Accounting and Auditing Organization for Islamic Financial Institutions (AAOIFI), Labuan Financial Services Authority, Financial Reporting Foundation, and also Advisor to the Sri Lanka Securities & Exchange Commission.

He is currently Chairman of JcbNext Berhad and Enra Group Berhad, a Board Member of Glomac Berhad, Citibank Berhad, Ekuinas (National Private Equity Corporation) and several other private companies and foundations.
